



This cycle map for Gosport has been developed as part of the My Journey campaign, which aims to encourage more people to make greater use of walking, cycling, bus or rail in their everyday journeys.

A flat terrain and a good network of cycle tracks and lanes makes it easy to cycle in Gosport. There are interesting places to visit including 6 miles of accessible coastline stretching from Gosport Town Centre to Lee on the Solent via National Cycle Network Route 2, where you can relax and enjoy the best views of Portsmouth Harbour, the Solent and the Isle of Wight. The frequent ferry service between Gosport and Portsmouth carries bicycles, and is popular with both commuter and leisure cyclists. Now you can even cycle to Fareham via the Eclipse busway (open to cyclists) and cycle paths that use former railway lines.

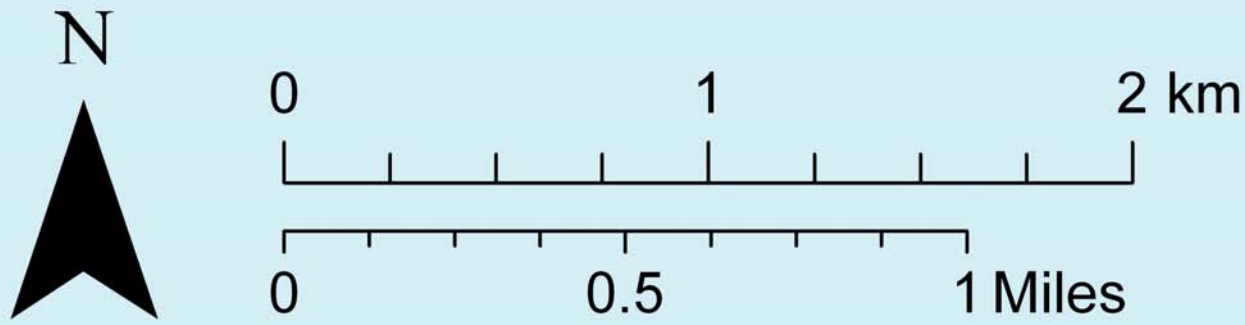

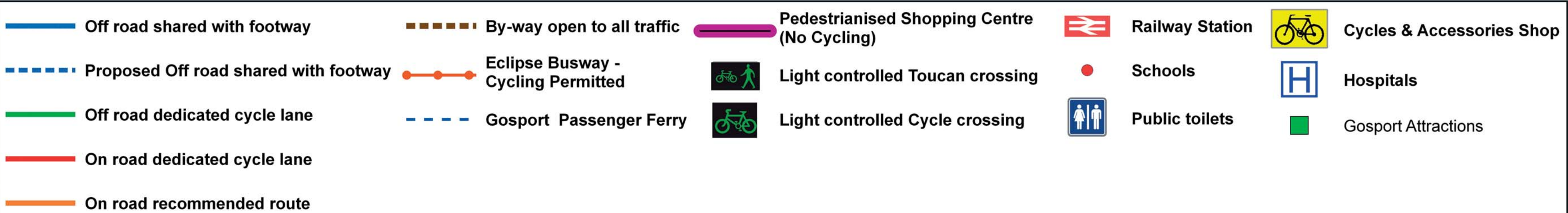
Gosport Cycle Map

Unsegregated Shared Cycle Route

Pedestrians and cyclists can mix freely and share the full width of the route



Segregated Shared Cycle Route

When using segregated tracks cyclists **MUST** keep to the side intended for cycles as the pedestrian side remains a pavement or footpath.
