A flat terrain and a good network of cycle tracks and lanes makes it easy to cycle in Gosport. There are interesting places to visit including 6 miles of accessible coastline stretching from Gosport Town Centre to Lee on the Solent via National Cycle Network Route 2, where you can relax and enjoy the best views of Portsmouth Harbour, the Solent and the Isle of Wight. The frequent ferry service between Gosport and Portsmouth carries bicycles, and is popular with both commuter and leisure cyclists. Now you can even cycle to Fareham via the cyclists and solve to cycle to Fareham via the Eclipse busway (open to cyclists) and cycle paths that

Gosport Cycle Map




