JUBILEE SAILING TRUST (JST) ★

Based in Woolston, operated the only two tall ships to take disabled crews - LORD NELSON & TENACIOUS

LORD NELSON

First tall ship designed to take mixed ability crews. Decommissioned 2019

COLIN MUDIE

Tall ship & Yacht designer. Designed LORD NELSON & first ROYALIST. Max Mudie's father

**Sir WINSTON CHURCHILL
MALCOLM MILLER**

STA schooners designed by Camper & Nicholsons

MARTIN SNAPE

1852 - 1930
Famous Gosport artist.
Many local & maritime subjects

Sir TOMMY SOPWITH

(1888 - 1989)
English aviation pioneer, business executive and yachtsman. Raced J Class. Funded a yacht for the Ocean Youth Club

J - CLASS

Big sailing yachts that took part in the America's Cup in the 1930s..

INTERNATIONAL SAIL TRAINING ASSOCIATION (ISTA)

Organised the first tall ships race in 1956. Based in Mumby Road until 2001

OCEAN YOUTH CLUB (OYC) ★

1960 - 1999 had a fleet of yachts for youth sail training. Based in Gosport Bus Station

ROYALIST CITY LIVERYMAN VIGILANT

Sea Cadet tall ship, and yachts, respectively. All now retired

JUAN SEBASTIAN DE ELCANO/ ESMERALDA

113m long tall ships designed by C E Nicholson

GIPSY MOTH IV

Yacht built at Camper & Nicholsons for Sir Francis Chichester who sailed round the world in her in 1967

FOUDROYANT

1816 wooden war-ship used as training ship in Portsmouth Harbour until 1986

ENDEAVOUR & ENDEAVOUR II

J-class built at Camper & Nicholsons for Sir Tommy Sopwith

CAMPER & NICHOLSONS

World famous boat builders. Site now called Endeavour Quay

Sir ROBIN KNOX -JOHNSTON

Famous yachtsman. Won the Golden Globe race in 1968

SAIL TRAINING INTERNATIONAL (STI)

Current organisers of tall ships races. Based in Endeavour Quay (near old Camper & Nicholsons yard)

LONDON SAILING PROJECT ★

Youth based sail training organisation, based on the Hamble but for a while in Gosport

ASSOCIATION OF SAIL TRAINING ORGANISATIONS (ASTO)

Since 1970. Charity that looks after all UK sail training organisations. Based in Clarence Yard. ★ = members

SEA CADETS OFFSHORE ★

Offshore office is based in Fort Blockhouse

ROYALIST II SIR STELIOS CITY OF LONDON JOHN JERWOOD JACK PETCHEY

Current Sea Cadet fleet. A brig, 2 yachts, 2 power vessels

ALEX THOMSON RACING

ALEX THOMSON

Single handed sailor sponsored by Hugo Boss, based in Gosport

COLIN BAXTER

Local marine artist. Knows about Gosport, tall ships, maritime history

SUHAILI

The yacht Sir Robin Knox-Johnston's won on in 1968, currently in Clarence marina

OCEAN YOUTH TRUST SOUTH ★

Took over from Ocean Youth Club. Based in Clarence Yard. Have a 30 metre ketch.

JOINT SERVICES ADVENTUROUS SAILING TRAINING CENTRE (JSASTC)

Founded in 1972 as Joint Services Sailing Club, became JSASTC in 1991. Provides sailing to HM forces. Based in Hornet Services Sailing Club, Haslar Creek.

NICHOLSON 55s

JSASTC had a fleet of these yachts, designed and built by Camper & Nicholsons

CLIPPER RACES

Round the world yacht races organised by Sir Robin Knox - Johnston. Based in Clarence Yard
